• First African Startup conference organized by an German-Ivoirian and French Collaboration

Abidjan, Berlin, Paris, August 26th 2019– GCAF, the German non-profit organization founded by the investment company GreenTec Capital Partners, is organizing, in collaboration with le LAB, a well-recognized French organization active in supporting entrepreneurs in Africa for more than 5 years, conference the #EntrepreneursOnTheMove: Investing in Africa's Future (#EOM) from October 2nd to 4th 2019 in Abidjan, Côte d'Ivoire together with the Chamber of Commerce of Côte d'Ivoire. #EOM will serve as the platform to build capacity of entrepreneurs, investors and enablers and connect key stakeholders within African entrepreneurship ecosystems and beyond.

The goal is to catalyze actions towards supporting and investing in African entrepreneurs so that they can grow and scale their businesses. The conference follows a pan-African approach that shall bring together stakeholders from different regions of the continent.

As the event is a collaboration is between Ivoirian, German and French players, the idea of bringing different stakeholders together to achieve more than each could do individually is its guiding principle. For that reason #EOM will serve as a linking point between enablers, startups, investors and policy makers. So that targeted actions can be derived from the discussions, masterclasses and workshops.

During #EOM entrepreneurs will have the opportunity to connect with their peers from other countries as well as investors and pan-African enablers who might be able to support them on their way.

Invited investors will take part in an ecosystem tour to get to know the entrepreneurial ecosystem in Côte d'Ivoire and benefit from match making with potential investees. A special focus of the event will lie on the youth and female entrepreneurs, as female entrepreneurs have proven to be successful, driven and have a high impact on their

environment when their businesses are running well. Altogether, more than 70 Startups will directly benefit from #EOM in form of prize money, capacity building and international exposure.
